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RAMESHBABU PRAGGNANANDHAA



Rameshbabu Praggnanandhaa, the Indian chess prodigy also the new kid in the grandmaster block. Mastering International chess at the age of 10, the youngest at the time, and a grandmaster at the age of twelve, the second-youngest at the time. He became the youngest player to defeat the then-world champion Magnus Carlsen in a rapid game in the Airthings Masters Rapid Chess Tournament on 22 February 2022, at the age of 16.

Family and Education

Praggnanandhaa was born to a humble family on August 10, 2005, in Chennai, Tamil Nadu. His father, Rameshbabu, is a TNSC Bank Branch Manager, and his mother, Nagalakshmi, is a homemaker who frequently accompanies him to National and International tournaments. In Chennai, he attended the Velammal Main Campus. He is the younger brother of R. Vaishali, a Woman Grandmaster and International Master herself.

Career

His infatuation towards chess began after watching his sister play the chess prodigy achieved his first success at the age of seven in 2013, when he won the Under-8 World Youth Chess Championship. He has earned the title of FIDE Master as a result of his victory. In 2015, the player won the U-10 title for the second time. Praggnanandhaa was crowned the Youngest International Master in 2016 at the age of ten years, ten months, and nineteen days. The next year, at the World Junior Chess Championship, he earned his first Grandmaster Norm.

Praggnanandhaa became the second youngest Grand Master in the year 2018 at the age of 12 years. He achieved an extraordinary achievement by defeating Luco Moroni in the Gredine Open in Italy.

Praggnanandhaa is only the third Indian after Viswanathan Anand and Pentala Harikrishna to defeat World Champion Magnus Carlsen at the online Airthings Masters in 2022. He was the youngest person ever to defeat the reigning world champion. Praggnanandhaa, who is only 18 years old, defeated world number three Fabiano Caruana in a tie-breaker to advance to the FIDE World Cup final. After Viswanathan Anand, he became only the second Indian to accomplish the feat. His love and passion for the game always draw high notes of gratification, when once, after his international tour, he received a grand welcome he was noted saying, "I am very happy to see so many people coming here and it is good for chess."



MESSAGE FROM PRINCIPAL



The world is undergoing rapid changes in the knowledge landscape. With various dramatic scientific and technological advances, such as the rise of big data, machine learning, and artificial intelligence, many unskilled jobs worldwide may be taken over by machines, while the need for a skilled workforce, particularly involving mathematics, computer science, and data science, in conjunction with multidisciplinary abilities across the sciences, social sciences, and humanities, will be increasingly in greater demand.

In school education, the National Education Policy 2020 stresses on the core values and principle that education must develop not only the cognitive skills, that is, – both 'foundational skills' of literacy and numeracy and 'higher-order' thinking skills such as critical thinking and problem solving – but also, social and emotional skills - referred as 'soft skills' -including cultural awareness and empathy, perseverance and grit, teamwork, leadership, communication, skills. The Policy aims and aspires to universalize the pre-primary education and provides special emphasis on the attainment of foundational literacy and numeracy in primary level and beyond for all by 2025. It recommends a plethora of reforms at all levels of school education which seek to ensure the quality of schools, transformation of the curriculum, reformation in the current Exam Patterns and Assessment criteria system, strengthening Teachers Potentials, and restructuring the education regulatory framework. It recommends that the curriculum load in each subject should be reduced to its 'core essential' content by creating a pace for holistic, discussion and analysis-based learning.

Holistic development is a complete educational strategy that aims to develop physical, intellectual, emotional, cognitive, and social abilities of kids. It seeks to enhance these skills in the early stage of life, which will prepare them to meet the challenges and difficulties of daily life in their future.

IN DAV, we strive to empower our children with 21st century skills by focusing on the four Cs – Communication, Collaboration, Creativity and Critical thinking and enabling their physical and mental wellness as well.

TEACHERS' DAY

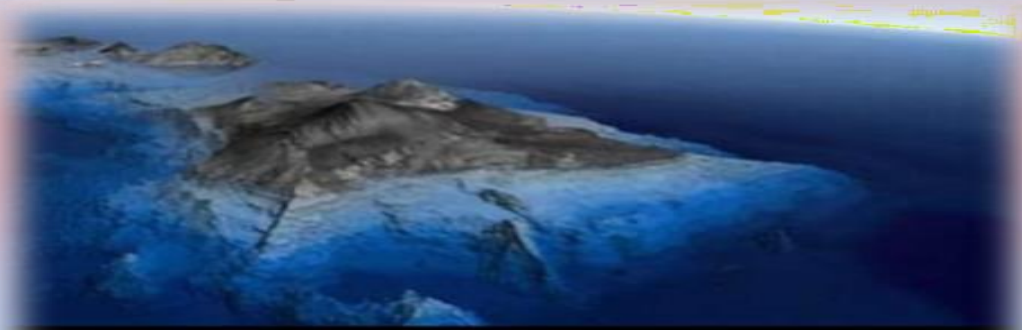

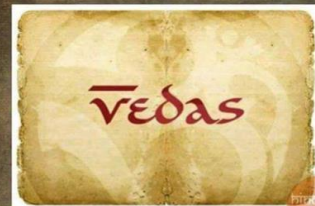


Nikola Tesla gathered concepts from Swami Vivekananda and Indian Vedas for his world-acclaimed work on Free Energy .
