PULI THEVAR

Puli Thevar was a Tamil Palaiyakkara who ruled Nerkattaanseval, situated in the Sankarankoil Taluk, Tenkasi, Tamil Nadu. He was the first leader in South Tamil Nadu who denied to pay tax (which was collected in the form of paddy) to the Britishers. For this reason his kingdom was given the name Nerkattaanseval (நெல் வரி கட்டாத செவ்வயல் பூமி).

He is notably fighting against East India Company at 1759 - 1761 in India. Ondiveeran and Venni Kaladi were the generals of Thevar's army, to fight against the East India company. He is known for the Polygars revolt against the British. He maintained a good relationship with the Kingdom of Travancore but later the allegiance was broken by one Yusuf Khan.

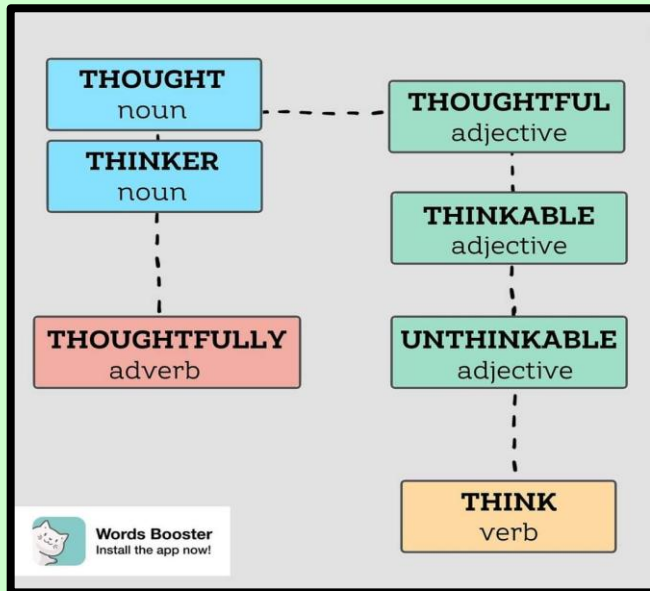

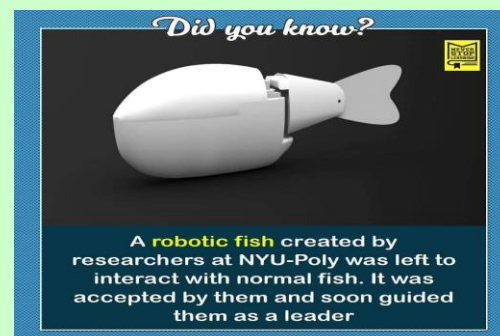
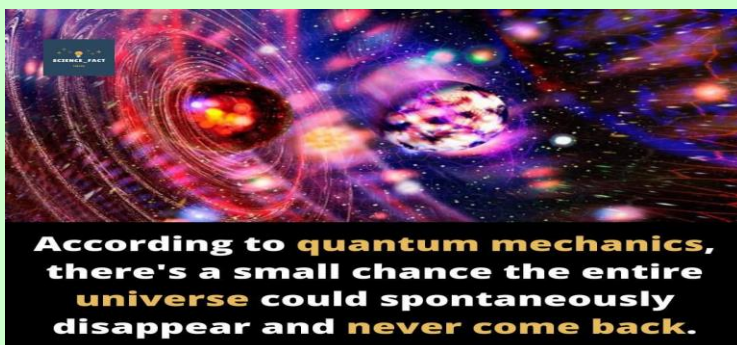
