From Principal's Desk

The world is undergoing rapid changes in the knowledge landscape. With various dramatic scientific and technological advances, such as the rise of big data, machine learning, and artificial intelligence, many unskilled jobs worldwide may be taken over by machines, while the need for a skilled workforce, particularly involving mathematics, computer science, and data science, in conjunction with multidisciplinary abilities across the sciences, social sciences, and humanities, will be increasingly in greater demand.

In school education, the National Education Policy 2020 stresses on the core values and principle that education must develop not only the cognitive skills, that is, – both 'foundational skills' of literacy and numeracy and 'higher-order' thinking skills such as critical thinking and problem solving – but also, social and emotional skills - referred as 'soft skills' -including cultural awareness and empathy, perseverance and grit, teamwork, leadership, communication, skills. The Policy aims and aspires to universalize the pre-primary education and provides special emphasis on the attainment of foundational literacy and numeracy in primary level and beyond for all by 2025. It recommends a plethora of reforms at all levels of

school education which seek to ensure the quality of schools, transformation of the curriculum, reformation in the current Exam Patterns and Assessment criteria system, strengthening Teachers Potentials, and restructuring the education regulatory framework. It recommends that the curriculum load in each subject should be reduced to its 'core essential' content by creating s pace for holistic, discussion and analysis-based learning.

Holistic development is a complete educational strategy that aims to develop physical, intellectual, emotional, cognitive, and social abilities of kids. It seeks to enhance these skills in the early stage of life, which will prepare them to meet the challenges and difficulties of daily life in their future.

In DAV, we strive to empower our children with 21st century skills by focusing on the four Cs – Communication, Collaboration, Creativity and Critical thinking and enabling their physical and mental wellness as well.

SENGOL CEREMONY




<u>PRITHVI VANDANAM</u>






